

INTRODUCTION:

ISL will show up a small 7 level battery-icon and the current time (24h/12h) in the right corner of the status line (they cover the busy and the battery indicator).

Now ISL also speeds up your keyboard (faster scrolling etc.) and has an autostart function (ISL starts any program you want, when you turn on your calculator). The new version of ISL is 30% smaller and will not decrease your computing power.

ISL even works when the calculator is turned off.

HOW TO USE ISL 2.1

How can I set the clock?

Press F1 → Clock... in the Homescreen.

How can I change the Time-Format?

Press Diamond & CLEAR and you can choose 24h/12h Time Format.

How can I change the display Mode?

Press **DIAMOND & CLEAR** and you can set the following display modes:

1. Clock and Battery:
ISL will display the battery icon and the clock
2. Clock Only
ISL will only display the clock
3. Battery Only
ISL will only display the battery icon

How can I use the auto start function?

Generate a basic program called: **isl_auto**. In this file you can put basic commands which will be started by ISL. For example: `homer()` (Starts an assembly program called `homer`, which shows a picture of Homer (Simpsons) at the startup)

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS:

Now ISL 2.1 works on a TI89, TI92+ and on a TI Voyage 200.

You need AMS 2.07 or higher.

Attention: I did not test ISL on a TI89/TI-92+ calculator.

INSTALLATION:

Send one of the files ISL.9xz (TI92+/TI Voyage 200) or ISL.89z (TI89) to your calculator and run it.

It will take some seconds until the clock appears the first time. After installation a small battery icon and a clock will appear at the bottom of the right corner.

Uninstall:

Send `uninevhk.9xz/uninevhk.89z` to your calculator and run it.

A menu will become visible with an entry called "ISL 2.1"

After selection "ISL 2.1" it will be removed.

VERSION INFO:

Version 2.1

- Auto start works even after apd has expired
- Higher clock-refresh-rate

Version 2.0

- ISL is now 30% smaller
- display-bug removed
- the busy indicator is no more disabled
- fast keyboard support

Version 1.31

- A bug on the TI89 is removed (no access to the menu by pressing DIAMOND & CLEAR)

Version 1.3

- ISL 1.3 do not decrease the computing power

- Now you can Select between Clock & Battery/Only Cloyk/Only Battery

Version 1.2

- Fully compatible with TI89, TI92+, TI-Voyage
- One file for two Time Formats (Press Dimond & CLEAR)

- Fast auto repeat Function added (for fast scrolling).
- A tiny Error with the 12h Timeformat removed.
